## **UN Refugee Agency Engagement with University Scholars Leadership Symposium 2016**

In August 2016, I had the honour of representing UNHCR's Regional Office for South-East Asia as the keynote speaker at the **7<sup>th</sup> University Scholars Leadership Symposium** in Hanoi, Vietnam.

The Symposium offered a unique platform to discuss one of the biggest humanitarian challenges facing the world today – forced displacement – with the bright young minds who are best placed to make a difference.
